# Town Budget Vote, May 7

It's time to cast your vote for the 2024-2025 town budget, including the revised Board of Education budget, that was recommended unanimously by the Board of Finance last month. Your presence is necessary at the **Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, May 7th at 7PM** in the Clune Center at Wilton High School, where eligible voters may offer comments and propose changes to the town budget. A motion can be made at the meeting to decrease the proposed school budget, and in-person votes are necessary to reject any further reductions. Please note that there is no Zoom option for participating in the Annual Town Meeting.

Voting begins immediately after the meeting and continues on Saturday, May 11th from 8AM to 6PM in the lobby of the Clune Center. The ballot this year also includes a number of bonding referendums as well as a question on whether the town charter should be amended to allow breweries in the Town of Wilton. A sample ballot is <u>available here</u>. More detailed information on the proposed budgets and bonding questions are <u>available on the town website</u>.
